A Digital Asset Management (DAM) product is a business solution for organizing, storing and retrieving rich media and managing digital rights and permissions. Media assets include photos, music, videos, animations, podcasts and other multimedia content. Digital Asset Management solutions provide a useful way to maintain a centralized repository for your project's files, allowing shared access to all up-to-date records and data.



Setting up your DAM Integration

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Welcome to DAM integration set up.

inMotion allows you to access files from your own DAM. Simply choose your file repository from the list at the left and permission inMotion to link to a designated folder or folders. This secure and protected access means that your files and designs can reside in your DAM and with one click appear as proofs. No need to upload and download. Server-to-Server connection to cloud based DAM solutions means that files pass behind the scenes and faster than ever.

How to Set Up Your DAM.
(The following presumes you have set up an account with the listed Cloud solutions at left. Don't see a preferred provider listed. Contact your inMotion support rep)


1. Choose the DAM provider.
2. Click the Enable Button that appears on next screen.
3. First time visitor log in to your provider with your known user name and password.
4. Click "Default Folder"


inMotion recommends setting up a specific folder on your DAM in advance to restrict upload access to that folder This will protect other valuable files and restrict inMotion users to your chosen folder.

5. Click "Restrict to this Folder" (you can change this in the future if needed by selecting "Change Root Folder")

Then, click on the DAM system you'd like to integrate on the left column of the page.

Once a DAM solution is chosen, you will be prompted by a series of instructions to assist you in enabling your account. The example provided below is for Dropbox:

Instructions to enable your account

1. Click the Enable Button.

We strongly recommend that admins set up their account's DAM integration(s) with a service account instead of a personal account. This will allow only the files that you want your users to access to be the only ones made available.
